- (2) Hold a Bachelor's degree;
- (3) Meet the admissions requirements (**and be admitted**) to Harvard Kennedy School to pursue the MC/MPA Edward S. Mason Programme; and
- (4) Complete an online application form for both the Mason Programme and the Fellowship.
